all of the cast and we highly recommend getting tickets! https://www.themaninthemoon.co.uk/



# Helping you keep your children safe.

CEOP has announced the launch of their <u>new website for 4 to 7 year olds</u> and accompanying <u>guide for parents and carers</u>.



The website is based on the three episode <u>Jessie & Friends</u> animated series, which aims to equip 4 to 7 year olds with the knowledge, skills and confidence they need to stay safer online.

The website is divided into sections for 4 to 5 and 6 to 7 year olds and features relevant and age appropriate games for the chosen age bracket. Each game focuses on one of four topics:

- Watching videos
- Chatting online
- Sharing pictures
- Gaming online

The **<u>guide</u>** aims to support parents and carers in navigating the website alongside their child. It provides information on the background and purpose of the website, in addition to information about each of the games and conversation starters to use with children.
