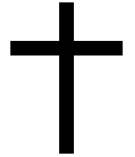

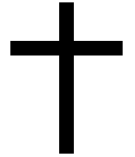
Year 1 have been busy studying the architecture of All Saints Church and they have produced some wonderful sketches depicting the key features. The children were asked the question 'what is a Church?'

CEOP has announced the launch of their [new website for 4 to 7 year olds](#) and accompanying [guide for parents and carers](#).



The website is based on the three episode [Jessie & Friends](#) animated series, which aims to equip 4 to 7 year olds with the knowledge, skills and confidence they need to stay safer online.

The website is divided into sections for 4 to 5 and 6 to 7 year olds and features relevant and age appropriate games for the chosen age bracket. Each game focuses on one of four topics:

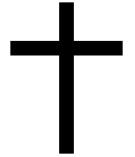
- Watching videos

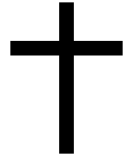

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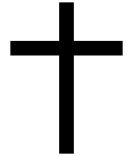
