## Is your child starting school in September 2023?

If your child was born between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019 you will need to apply for a school place between **31 October 2022** and **15 January 2023**.

Is your child in year 2? If your child attends an infant school you will need to apply for a place at a junior school or a primary school with a year 3 intake.

Deadline for applying for a reception place in schools is 15 January 2023.

Please note that parents in Year 2 will need to apply for a place at their preferred junior school by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2023.


