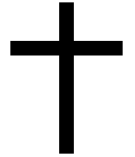

We are delighted to invite parents/carers to our **Harvest Festival** in the Jubilee Hall.

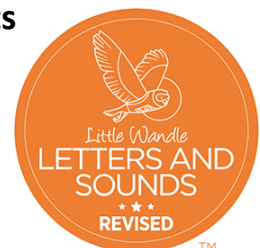
Entrance to The Jubilee Hall is via the staff car park, **please do not come through the playground** as the children will be using this route.

Little Wandle Phonics and Early Reading Evening for new Parents

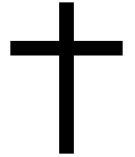
Thursday 6th October 7.15 – 8 pm

Well done to Ava in Puffins who has won the Robinsons Fantastic Fruit competition!

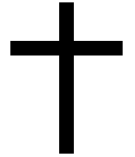
Ava has won a playground planter for our school, personalised window box, seed packets, book vouchers and gardening equipment for our whole class. Well done!

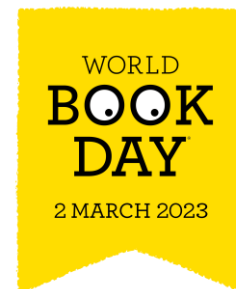

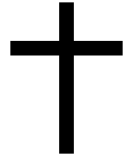
