The school council have chosen to learn more about the Child of Hope Charity in Uganda to help them gain a better understanding of life in another country. Child of Hope will be our chosen charity


and the children will be working together to help our friends in another continent.

Get Creative


A chance to be creative this National Creativity Day. Come along and let your creativity flow! Try out different media, including paint, charcoal, pen and ink, collage.
