## Little Wandle Workshop



In an effort to minimise the number of late applications received, SCC would like to remind parents, **including parents with pre-school siblings**, that the closing date for Reception and Junior applications for September 2024 entry is **15 January 2024**.

For infant schools, this will include reminding parents of children on roll in Year 2 that they must submit an application **by 15 January** for a Junior transfer.
